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TIPS ON HOW TO STORE SKIS AND SNOWBOARDS IN SELF STORAGE UNITS

FIRST CLEAN, TUNE & WAX

Clean dirt, salt, and moisture from the slopes as it can cause corrosion and deterioration. Applying a layer of wax helps prevent the base from drying out.



FIND A HEATED STORAGE UNIT

Storing your skis in a damp basement or attic isn't ideal. Look for a climate controlled or heated storage unit, and feel confident your gear will withstand the elements.

AVOID STACKING HEAVY ITEMS & USE WALL MOUNTS

Excessive pressure can damage bindings, boards, skis and other equipment. Keep equipment off the ground to avoid warping.



STORE ACCESSORIES PROPERLY

Boots and bindings should be stored in a cool, dry place, with buckles lightly fastened. Ski poles should be stored upright or hung to prevent bending.
